



The Golandsky Institute's 2010 Summer Symposium and International Piano Festival takes place from July 10th to July 18th in Princeton, NJ

Princeton, N.J. – May 12, 2010 –The Golandsky Institute has announced the performers for its [2010 International Piano Festival](#), to be held at Princeton University for its seventh summer, July 10th to July 18th. The Festival will feature six recitals by the brightest stars from the classical and jazz piano music worlds.

On Sunday, July 11th, at 8:00 p.m. Internationally acclaimed Turkish virtuoso, [Gulsin Onay](#) will perform a program of Beethoven, Chopin, and Bartok. Ms. Onay has won top prizes in international competitions and has performed throughout the world in more than 400 countries.

On Monday, July 12th, at 8:00 p.m., Spain's rising young artist, [Josu De Solaun Soto](#), First Prize winner, Jose Iturbi International Piano Competition and the European Union International Competition. Program includes Chopin Impromptu in F sharp, Sonata in B Minor, Szymanowski, Skryabin, and Mampou.

On Tuesday, July 13th at 8:00 p.m., Internationally recognized collaborative artist [Thomas Bagwell, piano and Christopher Dylan Herbert, Baritone](#), will perform a program which includes: Bach: Preludes and Fugues from the WTC and Schumann: Songs from "Liederkreis"

On Thursday, July 15th at 8:00 p.m., Bach Expert [Father Sean Dugan](#) will play a program featuring "Spirituality in Music" including Bach's: "The Little Catechism", excerpts from Liszt: "Harmonies Poétiques et Religieuses", and excerpts from Messiaen: "Vingt Regards sur l'Enfant Jesus".

On Friday, July 16th, at 8:00 p.m. [Ilya Itin](#), Internationally acclaimed recording artist and Leeds Gold Medalist, of Russia, will perform: Selections from: The 24 Preludes of Rachmaninov and Schubert Sonata in G Major, Opus 78, D984.

The Festival will conclude on Saturday, July 17th at 8:00 p.m. with rising talents from the Berklee School of Music's Global Jazz Institute, [Takeshi Ohbayashi and Christian Li](#), piano, and [Yang Jeonglim](#) on bass. They will perform with Berklee faculty members [Marco Pignataro](#) on sax and [Matt Marvugli](#) on flute. World-renowned pianist [Danilo Perez](#) serves as the Artistic Director of the Boston based [Berklee Global Jazz Institute](#).

All concerts will be held at Taplin Auditorium, Princeton University. Admission for the concerts is \$25. Tickets may be purchased at the door or online at the Golandsky Institute's website, www.golandskyinstitute.org.

The Golandsky Institute was founded in 2003 by Edna Golandsky, John Bloomfield, Robert Durso and Mary Moran. It is acknowledged as the preeminent center for the Taubman Approach, which instructs pianists in the art of coordinate movement, giving them the tools to play with brilliance and ease.
