The Golandsky Institute introduces *The Art of Rhythmic Expression*, the first installment of its Discovery Series. This three-disc DVD set provides an in-depth perspective on rhythmic playing and highlights its role in artistic expression.

On these DVDs, Edna Golandsky builds on fundamental principles of the Taubman Approach to show how the correct use of rhythm brings music to life and makes it more expressive. Included are these staples of piano repertoire: Chopin's Mazurka, Op. 17, No. 4 and Ballade, Op. 23; Mozart's Sonata, K. 332; and Schubert's Impromptus, Op. 90, Nos. 2 and 4. A 24-page example booklet is included.
