Prior to the formation of the Golandsky Institute three years ago, **Ms. Golandsky** was cofounder and Artistic Director of the Taubman Institute for twenty-six years. Ms. Golandsky combines an extraordinary ability to solve technical problems with a penetrating musical insight. Pianists and other musicians from all over the world study, coach and consult with Ms. Golandsky. At Princeton University, **Summer Symposium** participants -- both new to and experienced with the Taubman Approach -- will have the opportunity to learn first-hand from the person considered to be the master.

For many, the Golandsky Summer Symposium has been life changing. The faculty carefully designs the Symposium to be interactive, hands-on, dynamic, and thought provoking. The **2005 Summer Symposium** will include

 - Attend "CHOOSING CHANGE: A forum on the stages and factors of life-altering experiences", moderated by **Leo and Paula Gorelkin**
