PULITZER WINNING PIANIST TO PERFORM IN PRINCETON: Yehudi Wyner, named a Pulitzer Prize winner last month for a distinguished musical composition by an American that had its premiere performance in the United States in 2005, will perform at the Golandsky Institute International Piano Festival on Friday, July 21 in Taplin Auditorium. The Pulitzer was awarded for Mr. Wyner's piano concerto "Chlavi in Mano," which had its premiere at a Boston Symphony Orchestra concert in February. The pianist will also participate in a July 20 panel discussion on contemporary music at the Institute's Summer Symposium here, with Harvard's Christopher Hasty, Juilliard's Edward Bilous, and Princeton's Barbara White.
