Golandsky Institute Sets Its Symposium Schedule

The Golandsky Institute has announced the schedule of lectures, demonstrations, and panel discussions comprising its third annual Summer Symposium at Princeton University beginning this Sunday, July 16.

The Symposium is being presented concurrently with the Golandsky Institute International Piano Festival. Six Festival concerts, all scheduled for 8 p.m. in Taplin Auditorium, will begin on Sunday with pianist Kuo-Hsiang Lio (see Town Topics, July 5, for complete schedule).

Wednesday, July 19, 9 a.m., *The Art of Collaborative Concert Preparation*, with Thomas Bagwell, Mannes College of Music.

Wednesday, July 19, 1 p.m., *Haydn, Master of the Orchestra and Keyboard*, with William Nell, pianist and conductor.

Wednesday, July 19, 2 p.m., *Insights Into Learning: An Exploration Into New Trends in Arts Education*, with Edward Bilous, Julliard School of Music.

Thursday, July 20, 4:30 p.m., panel on contemporary music comprising Yehudi Wyner, composer and conductor; Edward Bilous, Julliard School of Music; and Barbara

White, Princeton University.

Friday, July 21, 4:30 p.m., *Toward a Rapprochement of Music Theory and Performance, Beginning with Rhythm*, with Christopher Hasty, Professor of Music, Harvard University.
